Legislative Summary – Week Seven – Friday, February 25, 2011

Week seven of the 2011 General Session of the Wyoming Legislature brings us near the end of the session. Friday was the last day for bills to get off of general file in the second house, and subsequently, Monday is the last day for bills to get off second reading, and Tuesday, the last day for bills to pass third reading. Monday is the last day for joint committee meetings to discuss interim topics. As such, Management Council will meet Tuesday, March 1<sup>st</sup>, upon adjournment, to assign interim topics.

Many bills are heading to conference committees to work out differences between the House and the Senate. Notably, the joint conference committee on the supplemental budget bill worked out a compromise starting with the Senate at \$346,135.00 and the House at \$6M (refer to WTA's Week Six Legislative Summary for a table of major areas of difference). Overall, the conference committee added \$40.660M to the original proposed supplemental budget of \$215M for a total of \$255.66M. WTA will have a full analysis of the entire budget next week. The following table illustrates the major areas of compromise:

#### **BILLS OF INTEREST THIS WEEK**

HB 147 – EXCISE TAX – VENDOR COMPENSATION – Provides a credit to vendors for the collection and payment of sales and use tax. The engrossed version of the bill provides a credit of 1.95% if the amount of the tax remitted is less than or equal to \$6,250.00/month. If the monthly tax remitted is more than \$6,250, the credit is1% with a monthly maximum of \$1,000. All direct payors are still included in the bill, but would be subject to the \$1,000 monthly cap. The bill passed the House with a vote of 54-6 on February 3<sup>rd</sup> and an affirmative voice vote on Senate General File on Friday, February 25th. A standing committee amendment was adopted to provide \$165,000 for DOR to administer the bill. HB 147 bill be on Senate second reading on Monday, March 1<sup>st</sup>. WTA supports this bill.
